Call out for a Legislative Committee

As per the Muskeg Lake Cree Nation's Election Act, the process to make recommended changes to our current Election Act must be completed accordingly.

Amendments:

24. Amendments to the Act may be made only through a proper process at a duly convened Assembly of voters. A duly convened assembly of voters requires fourteen (14) days notification to all resident and non-resident members of the Muskeg Lake Cree Nation.
25. The process for the amendment shall involve the following stages:
 - a. Recommendations for amendments shall be made in writing by the Chief Headman or members of the Muskeg Lake Cree Nation submitted to the Chief Executive Officer;
 - b. The Chief Executive Officer should acknowledge receipt of the recommendations for amendment and table the proposed changes before a Committee of Council to be called the "Legislative Committee". This committee shall be constituted by the Chief, Headman, one (1) who is not a member of Muskeg Lake Cree Nation and representatives of the Family Representatives Council, if established.
 - c. The Legislative Committee shall prepare proposed amendments and place before membership for consideration at a duly convened Assembly.
 - d. Any amendments placed before an Assembly must be properly moved, seconded and adopted.
 - e. For amendments to be effective, they must be ratified by a majority of electors (50% + 1) present at the Assembly.
