

If you would like to open a personal bank account with First Nations Bank of Canada to receive your **MUSKEG LAKE CREE NATION 1919 SOLDIER SETTLEMENT TRUST** per capita distribution, you can do this in three different ways:

1. Travelling to Saskatoon, Meadow Lake, or Edmonton to visit our branch located at:

- a. **Saskatoon Branch**, 224 – 4th Ave South, Saskatoon SK
- b. **Flying Dust Branch**, 8004 Flying Dust First Nation, Meadow Lake SK
- c. **Enoch Branch**, 100 – 21553 Chief Lapotac Blvd, Enoch AB

OR

2. Going online to the First Nations Bank of Canada's website to open a bank account online. The application takes between 5 to 20 minutes to complete, depending on your connection speed and the information you have available.

Once we receive your application, we will reach you by your preferred contact method to obtain further details and validate your identification – see at the bottom of this page for further instructions.

3. Requesting a paper bank account application form. Simply contact our **Saskatoon Branch** by calling toll free at **1-844-459-1606** or emailing FNBC.Service@fnbc.ca and request a remote account opening kit be mailed to you for completion. Please ensure to provide your name, address, and contact information. Once you have completed the required documentation, return it to the Branch by mailing it to:

IDENTITY VERIFICATION NEEDED TO OPEN A FIRST NATIONS BANK OF CANADA BANK ACCOUNT

To open your First Nations Bank of Canada personal bank account, a First Nations Bank of Canada representative will ask to view and verify your photo identification – for example, your **driver's license, status card, or passport**. If you do not have an original, valid and unexpired photo identification, we may verify your information by accessing your **credit file**, or you may provide us with **2 separate, acceptable and recent documents containing your name and i) address, ii) birth date and/or iii) credit statement – such as your most recent utility bill and credit card statement** – to verify your identity.
