

Good afternoon parents and guardians,

I would like to inform you that we will be **re-implementing masking** at kihiw waciston school effective **MONDAY, JANUARY 16, 2023**.

We have had an increase of students coming to school sick and in turn our staff are beginning to get sick. We need everyone here every day and working in a safe environment. With that we will be re-implementing masking at school.

We will provide masks on the bus and at the school. Masks outdoors (recess, Land Based) will not be required. Instead, **when we are in close quarters in the classroom and hallways we will be wearing masks.**

I want to stress that there has not been any covid in the school. This is in response to viral flus, RSV and Strep throat- the "Tri-Demic". There is also concern about another covid variant that may come to communities.
